² To follow continuous chanting column, where the śloka is chanted without interruption and repeated once, please refer to Sri-Rudram-Learning-Method-2-Anuvakam-2.mp3 or Sri-Rudram-Learning-Method-3-Anuvakam-2.mp3 where no repetition accrues.

³ When following the learning column the last namaḥ is always chanted as namaḥ. When following the continuous chanting column with the learning method 2 audio source one can notice that all sandhi rules which were noted in the learning column are now followed, but still the last namaḥ is chanted as namaḥ. Only in the last audio source learning method 3, namaḥ is actually chanted as namo. This is because of the sandhi rule described below.

⁴ Sandhi rule followed when ślokas are chanted without interruption: aḥ becomes o before soft consonants and before a (namaḥ namaḥ > नमो नमः namo namaḥ).

⁶ Sandhi rule: a-dvaya becomes au before o-dvaya (vārivaskṛtāya auṣadhīnām > वारिवस्कृतायौषधीनां vārivaskṛtāya uṣadhīnām; uttama ojas > उत्तमौजस् uttamaujas).

⁷ Sandhi rule: two vowels of the same class combine into a long one: a + a > ā; a + ā > ā; ā + a > ā; ā + ā > ā (uccairghoṣāyā ākṛandayate > उच्चैर्घोषायाक्रन्दयते uccairghoṣāyākṛandayate; nitya ānanda > नित्यानन्द nityānanda).
